Emma Abiri was not able to visit with her Daisy Troop 20396, but that didn't stop her from donating on another day.





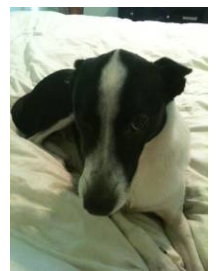
